PARENTS-TEACHER MEETING

- The development of a child is a joint responsibility of the parents and the teachers. The parents are expected to come and discuss their concerns related to their wards with the teachers in the 'PTM' as child's academic achievement, mental growth, emotional stability, psychological behavior and many other related areas influencing the child's total personality development.
- Any change of address or the mobile number of the child's parents / guardian must be immediately intimated to the school authorities.
- Parents are also advised to discourage their sons from growing / keeping beards for the sake of the idea of oneness which we try to promote at the school.
- The parents who do not care to attend the Parent-Teacher meetings will be deemed to be not interested in their child's education as this meeting is important to their child's progress.
- Parents of academically weak students or students with conduct problems must never fail to attend the Parent-Teacher meetings otherwise they will be deemed to be disinterested in their ward's educational progress and character development.
- Fee Defaulters for consecutive two months will not be permitted to sit in the Periodic Test.

The school will remain closed for students on the day of their PTM only. Any change (if made in the future) depends on the School Authority's discretion.

TRANSPORT

- 1. Transport is available on-demand. If there is any need to change the mode of transport, then information must be given before a month in writing. If a child is withdrawn for any reason he/she can't be taken back in the future or it depends on the availability of the seat in the same transport. The Co-operation of parents is vital during the session.
- 2. Children using transport facilities should be present at the pickup point at least 5 minutes before the given time.
- 3. Parents are requested not to make the transport wait as this causes inconvenience to others and delays the children's arrival at school.
- 4. Parents of children using their transport are requested to drop and pickup the child from the school gate incharge.
- 5. The school authorities have no responsibility for any accident/mishap on the way from the school to the destination and vice versa.
- 6. Parents of the students availing transport facility should be present at the designated stop 5 minutes before transport arrival & dispersal time.
- 7. Make sure that your ward does not carry any mobile phone in school conveyance.
- 8. Indecent behaviour in vehicles will lead to withdrawal of transport facility.

SCHOOL FEE

- 1. Fee is charged for 12 months in a year.
- 2. The fee has to be deposited by the 10th of every month. Thereafter late fee of Rs. 4/- per day will be charged for every calendar month.
- 3. If parents fail to pay the school fee for three consecutive months, the school has the right to struck off the name. Re-admission will depend on the number of seats vacant in the respective class and re-admission fee will be charged.
- 4. Separate reminders to Fee defaulters will not be issued.
- 5. Fee for May & June, Dec. & Jan., Feb & March must be deposited by 10th of May, Dec. & Feb. respectively.
- 6. Board Examination fee to be deposited in August.
- 7. In case of withdrawal during the session, no fee will be refunded, as well as the parents must submit the fee of next three months.
- 8. The Exam fee is to be deposited twice in a year: July & Jan.
- 9. T.C. Fee is Rs.100/- and duplicate T.C. fee will be Rs.200/- which will be issued after submission of an Affidavit.
- 10. The Fee for any other kind of certificate will be Rs. 50/-.
- 11. Rs.100/- will be charged as the student's I- Card fee in April.
- 12. If payment is made by cheque and it bounces than a fine of Rs.200/- & late fee will be charged accordingly.
- 13. Any change (if made in future) depends on the school authority's discretion.
- 14. All dues must be cleared till January for classes X & XII.
